We recommend the bobcat sites 272-285 and 255-259 that you can book directly with the StageCoach.

Option 2 – 10 mile trail Road S22, Montezuma Valley Rd. Ranchita, CA 92066

Option 3 – Never Leave Camp.

- When you return from hiking, - Please cross your name off the White Board.

- 1-4 PM, Pickle Ball in the sports court, and hang in the pool

- 5:00 PM Saturday Evening - Potluck Dinner and Down-Downs at the Desert Sky Pavilion. (BYOD – Bring your own drink and plate)

- 8-10 PM hang at the Coyote Pack Fire ring - Camp quiet hours start at 10pm

- 10 PM Optional Hash. Meet at the Starlight Telescope Pad for an Optional Hash. Everything is optional, short, and flat. Shoes and flashlights suggested.

## Sunday Morning pack up and go home...

- Sunday 10am ish Semi-Organized trip to the Mud Caves, a 30 miles south on S2. Bring flashlight/headlight, water, flashlight and a mask for dust. 4WD's or SUV's preferred for 5 miles of flat sandy off-road, but most regular cars can make it.
